



Regulatory Compliance

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005: Article 11 places a duty on the 'Responsible Person' to make and give effect to such arrangements to secure the safety from fire. These arrangements must be suitably documented and referenced against the applied fire risk profile and enforcement criteria.



Requirements

A Fire Strategy is a strategic document which references all fire safety provisions and the means of escape provisions employed in a building against applied enforcement criteria and the requirements of Building Regulations Approved Document 'B' or British Standard 9999.

A Fire Strategy is a complex, strategic document, which incorporates and the fire safety engineered solutions against the evacuation policy and the requirement of Building Regulations Approved 'chosen design guide. The Strategy must identify demonstrate compares compliance with legislative requirements referencing the employed solutions engineered and evacuation strategies against legislative performance and auditing standards.
